Please find enclosed further signatures in relation to the growing support for the community petition to Keep Ringwood Pool Open.

As of today Friday 29th March, 2011 we are presenting

- A further 2023 hard copy signatures

The petition states that:

Because the proposed redevelopment of RAC has fallen through, we as a community demand that:

- 1: The closure of RAC be delayed until a clear alternative redevelopment plan is in place.
- 2: Any alternative redevelopment plans must match or extend the existing facilities (5 metre diving platform, 50 metre lane pool, heated health and activity pool and disabled access).

These signatures are in addition to those submitted to Council on 23rd March 2011 prior to the Open Council meeting held on the 28th March - Reference Item 2 (page 25) of the Council Notice Paper.
