## Celia Wordsworth with Elf, Santa and Frosty

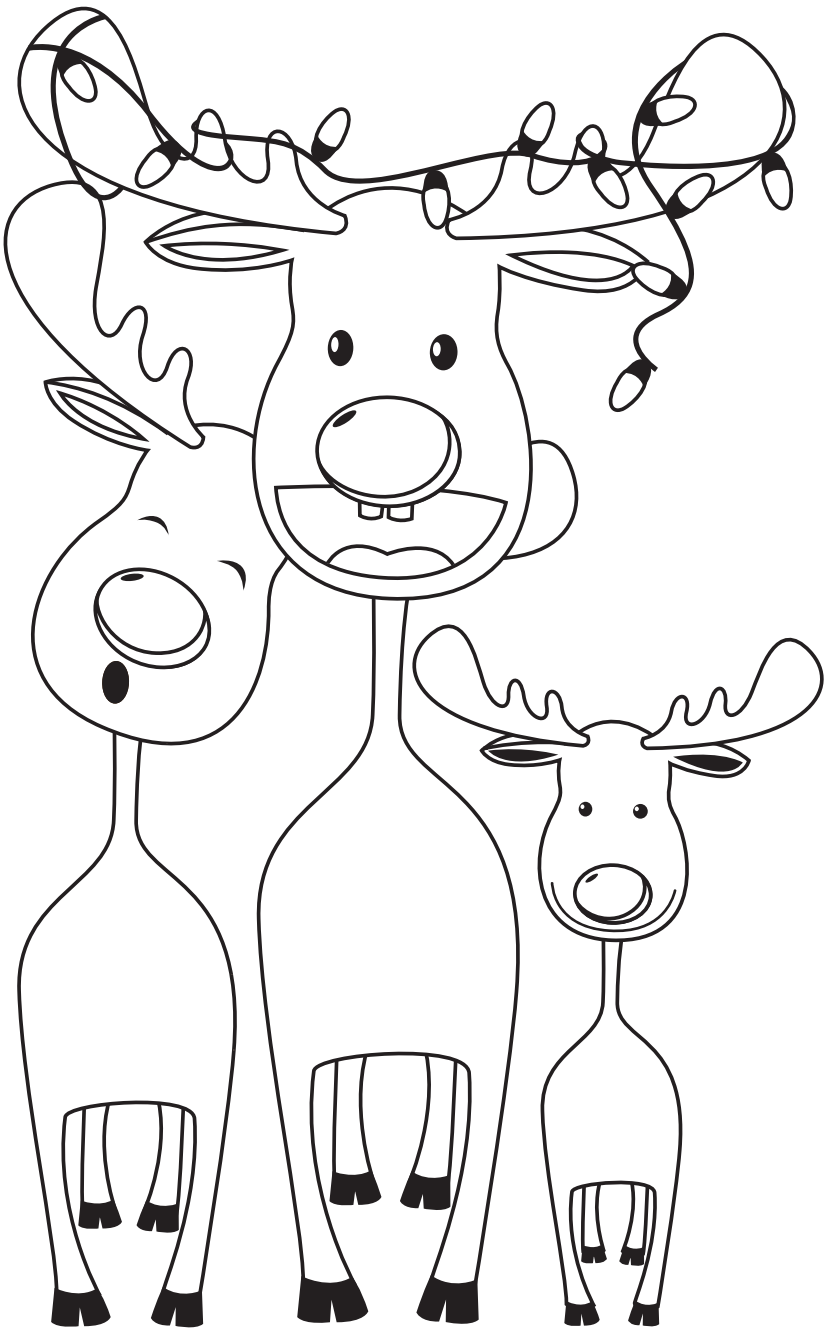
Celia Wordsworth has been writing, producing and performing children's musical theatre for over 15 years.

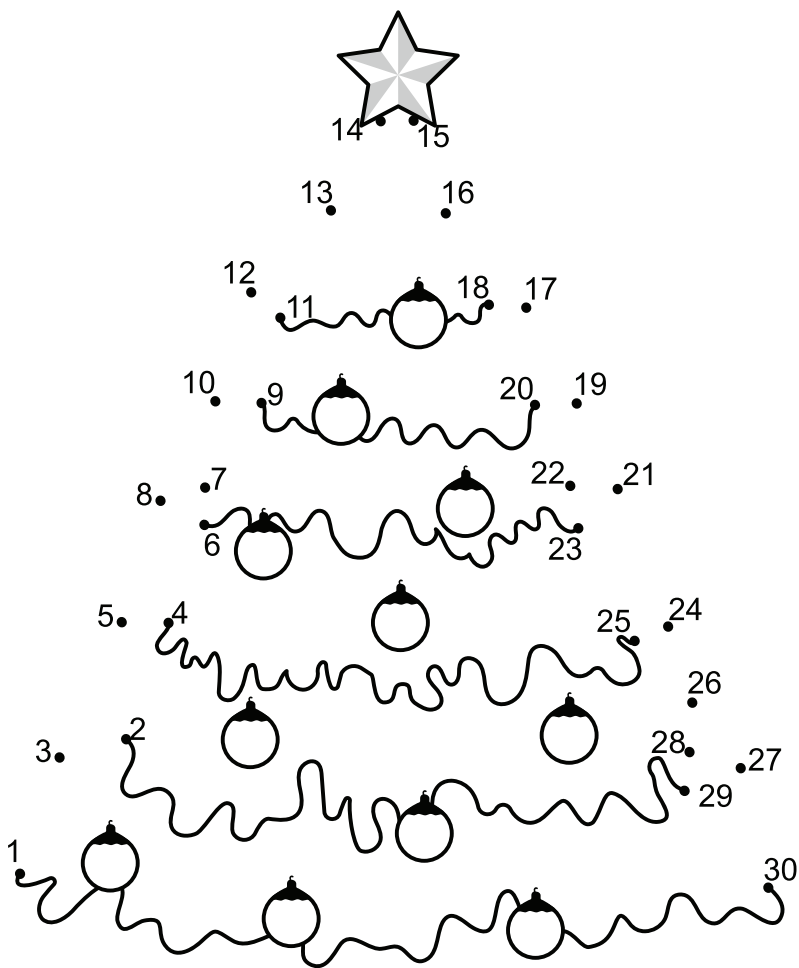

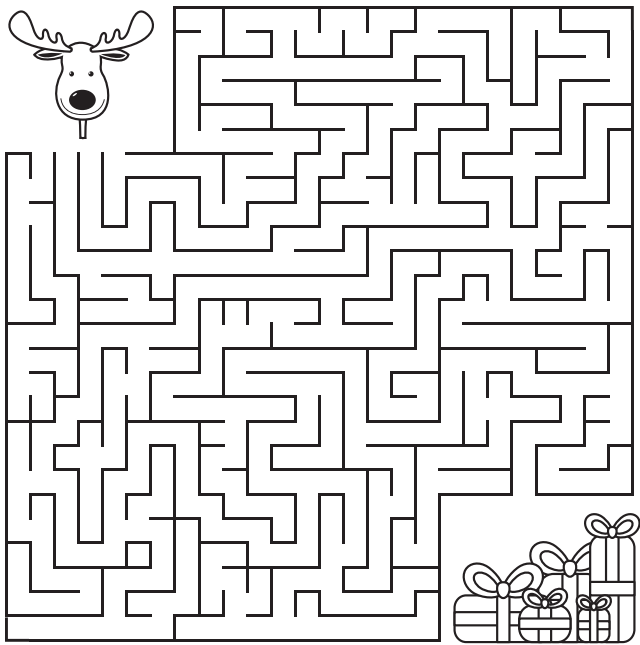

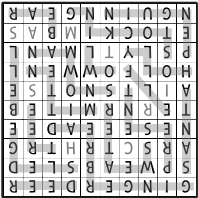
