- Branches (up to 10cm diameter and 40cm in length)
- Bread

- Council-supplied liners

- Fruit and vegetable scraps and peelings
- Grains e.g. quinoa, couscous, bran, oats

- Garlic
- Grass
- Herbs and spices
- Hair human and pet hair

- Logs (up to 10cm diameter and 40cm in length)
- Lollies and other confectionary
- Meat
- Mouldy, expired, best-before date food
- Napkins
- Newspaper (only 1-2 sheets used to wrap food waste)
- Noodles
- Nuts
- Onion
- Paper straws
- Paper towel (only 1-2 sheets used to wrap food waste)
- Pasta
- Pastries
- Pet food
- Plate scrapings
- Poultry
- Prunings (up to 10cm diameter and 40cm in length)

- Rice
- Sauces and condiments (tomato, mustard, aioli etc)
- Seeds
- Shellfish (soft shells only - for example crab, lobster, prawns)
- Soups, curries and sauces
- Spreads (vegemite, peanut butter, jam etc.)
- Sticks
- Straw and hay (excluding straw and hay used for animal bedding/waste - for example rabbit, guinea pig)
- Tea leaves
- Tinned foods (emptied out of can)
- Tissues
- Tofu/tempeh/textured vegetable protein (TVP)
- Twigs
- Yoghurt
- Weeds
- Wooden cutlery, toothpicks and skewers

Please remove all packaging before putting food in your caddy or FOGO bin.
